Recycling Regulations

The new build at the juniors is on schedule for completion in early May which is very exciting! The building is made up of three classroom spaces, two for the school to replace the old classrooms that were demolished. The further space will be a Flying Start provision managed by the local authority which will have its own access at the rear of the junior site.

Attendance

We would like to thank parents for your support with the children's attendance. The school's overall attendance to date is 94.1% which is slightly below our target of 95% (95% is equivalent to 10 days absent over the whole year). However we have a significant number of pupils who are well above this target.

We are also very grateful that nearly all the children arrive on time for school which allows a smooth start and is beneficial to the children as the learning begins straight away. A reminder that school starts at 9am in the infants and 8.45am in the juniors.
