- ✓ We will be implementing changes to our Infant practice in light of Welsh Government's Enabling Learning Guidance

Priority 3: Enhancing school improvement processes

- ✓ We will work with local schools on developing approaches to the teaching of reading
- ✓ We will work with the local authority and the Education Endowment Fund on developing pupils' independence in collaboration with other schools

Priority 2: Ensuring curriculum continuity and progression and the effective use of assessment to support pupils' learning

- ✓ We will be reviewing our curriculum coverage and how we track the work that is completed by the children
- ✓ We will be reviewing our assessment processes
- ✓ We will participate in the School of Sanctuary programme
- ✓ We will implement a new digital learning resource called DigiDen
